

## Ristigouche Census Project

To all interested members of the book world(s), including librarians, collectors, bibliographers, and others,

This letter announces the Ristigouche Census Project, undertaken by Henry Wessells, to trace all known copies of the first edition of *The Ristigouche and Its Salmon Fishing* by Dean Sage, published in an edition of 105 numbered copies by David Douglas of Edinburgh in 1888. Dean Sage (1841-1902), Albany lawyer, bibliophile collector, Grolier Club member, and salmon fisherman, drew upon his long experience to recount his adventures at Camp Harmony on the Restigouche River in New Brunswick (Ristigouche being the older form of the name). The book's chapter on angling literature reflects a long-standing interest in the subject; Sage's library catalogue (2 vols., 1896, 1904) remains an important document in the history of angling bibliography and collecting. He had a broad circle of acquaintances and presentations to several well known figures have been noted, including Samuel Clemens (present whereabouts of this copy unknown) and Stanford White.

The book was issued in a sturdy and elegant uniform binding (described on the census form) and all copies were numbered in consistent fashion. The aim of the census is to record location and number, together with any notable characteristics, such as presentation inscriptions, insertions, re-binding, etc., as well as evidence of ownership past and present.

Henry Wessells is an antiquarian bookseller with the firm of James Cummins Bookseller in New York City, specialists in sporting literature. Cooperation is solicited from institutional libraries and private persons, and all correspondence from private collectors will be treated as confidential. Preliminary research has identified more than three dozen of the 105 copies, though it has not been possible to verify locations for all of these. With your assistance, the census can be completed in time for the hundred-twenty-fifth anniversary of the book's publication. Publication of the results is intended.
